January 1999

(1) 1 January 1999: PCP member kidnapped by UPDF in Khagrachari

On 1/1/99 a PCP member named Samar Bijoy Chakma was kidnapped by the activists of anti-accord group from Kamalchari village under Khagrachari sadar upazila and inhumanly tortured. He was released on 3/1/99.

(2) 1 January 1999: Minor Jumma girl raped by Bengali settler in Guimara

On 1/1/99 one minor Jumma girl named Miss Besh Bala Tripura (Maya Rani) (12) d/o Amal Krishna Tripura of village Bailyachari Joutha Khamar under Guimara upazila in Khagrachari district was raped by a Bengali settlers named Babar Ali while she was alone in the house.

(3) 5 January 1999: Bengali bus driver outrage Jumma girl in Matiranga

On 5/1/99 one Bengali Bus driver whose name was not available outraged the modesty of an immature Jumma girl named Miss Mamata Devi Tripura (14) of village Alutilla hill under Matiranga upazila in Khagrachari district while going to Matiranga from Khagrachari by bus.

(4) 10 January 1999: Jumma youths arrested by the police in Khagrachari

On 10/1/99 the police authority of Khagrachari police station arrested the following Jumma youths from various villages under Khagrachari sadar upazila and three of them were punished for two months and fined TK. 5000/- each and rest two were released. The victims were -

(5) 10 January 1999: Police conducted operation through Khagrachari district

On 10/1/99 simultaneously the police forces of Mahalchari, Panchari, Dighinala, Matiranga, Ramgarh, Manikchari and Laxmichari upazilas under Khagrachari district conducted operation throughout Khagrachari district and arrested 37 Jumma youths from aforesaid upazila areas. Most of them were offenders of falsely accused youths during first conflict period. Some of arrested persons were -

(6) 14 January 1999: Jumma fishermen beaten up by the army in Longadu

On 14 January 1999 the victims who were innocent Jumma fisherman were inhumanly beaten up by the armed forces of Patachara camp and Yerengchari camp under Atarakchara union of Longadu upazila under Rangamati district and handed over to the Longadu police station later. They were falsely alleged to have collected illegal tolls.

- 1) Mr. Buddha Kumar Chakma (27) s/o Kiata Mohan Chakma of village Ultachari under Longadu upazila
- 2) Mr. Bhuban Bikash Chakma (20) of village Ultachari under Longadu upazila.

(7) 14 January 1999: Jumma youths arrested by the army in Dighinala

On 14/1/99 the following youths from 9-miles Gucchagram under Dighinala upazila were arrested by the army personnel of 8 mile army camp under Dighinala upazila and handed over to the Khagrachari police station later on. At first, they were picked up from their village by a Naik Subedar of said camp named Saheb in the name of discussion on a newly established club of that village. But instead of having discussion they were falsely accused in connection with illegal toll collection and handed over to the Khagrachari police authority. At the same time, a case was filed against them Dighinala police station over telephone by the armed forces. The arrested youths were -

(8) 15 January 1999: Jumma youths arrested by the army in Dighinala

On 15/1/99 the police authority of Dighinala police station conducted an operation in Bhoirafa Mukh under Dighinala upazila of Khagrachari district and arrested the following innocent Jumma youths. On the same day, the local people carried out a procession in protest against unjustified arrest of innocent youths and shouted slogan against minister of CHT ministry Mr. Kalpa Ranjan Chakma as because he ordered to arrest them. As a result, the police authority of Dighinala police station compelled to set free the youths later on. The arrested youths were -

(9) 16 January 1999: 4 PCP members tortured by the army in Kaptai

On 16 January 1999 the victims who were members of PCP (Assambasti Regional branch) were inhumanly beaten up by the subedar Md. Sowkat of Ranyachari camp under Kaptai brigade. That time they were going to Manikchari under Kaptai upazila for organizational purpose. The victims were:

(10) 18 January 1999: Two Jummas shot dead by forest guard in Kaptai

On 18/1/99 the following two Jummas were shot dead near Chowdhurychara forest post of Karnafuly range under Kaptai upazila in Rangamati district by a group of forest guard led by the Assistant Conservator of Forest Mr. Mamunur Rashid and Divisional Forest Officer Mr. Tapan Kanti Dey and forest guard Mr. Mamunur. The dead bodies were not handed over to their relatives. The victims were-

- 1) Mr. Pening Mong Marma (27) of Bajjya Tali, Kaptai upazila, Rangamati district
- 2) Mr. Mong Prue Marma Of village Bajjya Tali, Kaptai upazila, Rangamati

(11) 21 January 1999: Returnee refugee woman attacked by Bengali settler in Dighinala

On 21/1/99 while going to work in the farmland a refugee returnee woman named Ms. Purna Shova Chakma w/o Hemabrata Chakma of Betchari Bibhuti Ranjan Karbari Para under Merung union of Dighinala upazila was attacked with sharp metal knife (Daos) by a Bengali settler named Unus who has been all the time trying to occupy her land illegally. Purna Shova received injuries on her hand and other parts of the body. Other four Jumma persons who were working in her field saved her from death. It is mentionable that the next day the Bengali settlers of various settlements at Kobakhali, Pablakhali, Boalkhali, Baramerung and Chotamerung mouzas in Dighinala upazila shouted slogans with joy for the said incident.

(12) 21 January 1999: innocent Jummas tortured by the army in Baghaichari

On 21/1/99 the army from Baghaihat army camp under Baghaichari upazila attacked upon the Jumma people who came to Baghaihat Bazar and beaten them indiscriminately. As a result, the following Jummas were injured-

- 1) Mr. Tari Lal Chakma (Doctor) (40), Baghaihat, Baghaichari, Rangamati
- 2) Wife of Tari Laal Chakma
- 3) Mr. Tapan Chakma (Banshi Muni) s/o Bir Ranjan Chakma, Bangaltali, Baghaichari, Rangamati.

(13) 24 January 1999: PCP members attacked by anti-accord elements in Baghaihat

On 24/1/99 the activists of Prasit-Sanchoy group attacked on the PCP members at Baghaihat of Baghaichari upazila in Rangamati district. As a result many PCP members including Bijoy Chakma, president of PCP Baghaichari upazila branch were injured.

(14) 30 January 1999: PCJSS member beat up by anti-accord elements in Baghaichari

On 30/1/99 one PCJSS member named Riten Dewan (Niloy) s/o Abani Ranjan Dewan of Katthali under Baghaichari was beaten up by the anti-accord elements of Prasit-Sanchoy group led by Dilip Chakma of Katthali and Dhruva Jyoti Chakma of Jagarabil under Baghaichari upazila at his house. As a result he got injuries on his head.

(15) 31 January 1999: HWF member attacked by Bengali settlers and held by the army in Laxmichari

On 31/1/99 a number of Jumma students of PCP while going to attend a meeting at Laxmichari upazila headquarter in Khagrachari district were attacked by Bengali settlers where around 20 were severely injured. The jeep carrying the students of PCP having brakes failed killed a Bengali girl named Miss Angela Akhter (11) at Maghaichari area under Laxmichari upazila. Regarding with this killing the Bengali settlers of that area equipped with Daos, long sharp knives, sticks and spears made cruel attack upon the jeep driver and Jumma students as well and snatched money and other valuables from the Jumma students. Followings were the injured persons-

- 5) Mr. Aung Hla Gya Marma (19) s/o Kaung Chai Marma, Gobeshona, Khagrachari Sadar
- 6) Mr. Ching Sa Marma (21) s/o Ning Hla Marma, Dewan Para, Khagrachari upazila
- 7) Mr. Banga Chakma (22) s/o Ram Chandra Chakma, Khejur Bagan, Khagrachari Sadar
- 8) Mr. Braja Kishore Tripura (25) s/o Kulendra Tripura, Khagrapur, Khagrachari Sadar
- 9) Mr. Binotamoy Dhamai (21) s/o Shashanka Dhamai, Balyachari, Matiranga upazila
- 10) Mr. Bodi Chakma (20) s/o Datta Chakma, Mohajan Para, Khagrachari Sadar.

One female student leader of Hill Women's Federation named Ms. Dolly Prue was held by the army. She was falsely alleged of carrying weapon with her. That day the students were going to Laxmichari to attend a meeting. Unfortunately the jeep carrying them killed a Bengali girl named Angela Akter at Moghaichari and the Bengali settlers of that area made unjustified attack upon the jeep driver and the Jumma students as immediate retaliation. Later, the Jumma students went to the nearby army camp to take shelter where unexpectedly the army too reviled and forced the students standing in the sun keeping hands on their heads. They held Hill Women's Federation's member Ms. Dolly Prue was released on bail and the filed false case is yet to be withdrawn.

February 1999

(16) 1 February 1999: Jumma houses searched by the army in Dighinala

On 1/2/99 a group of army led by a subedar from Poaing Para army camp under Dighinala upazila in Khagrachari district conducted a searching operation at Kamakuchara of Dighinala. They searched the houses of the following villagers and harassed the innocent famili members of them:

- 1) Mr. Prem Ratan Chakma
- 2) Mr. Chigala Chakma
- 3) Mr. Shubha Kanti Chakma
- 4) Mr. Kitta Mongal Chakma
- 5) Mr. Sukha Shanti Chakma
- 6) Mr. Santu Chakma.

(17) 8 February 1999: Anti-accord elements filed false case against 6 innocent youths in Dighinala

On 8/2/99 two persons of the anti-accord activists namely Anada Moy Chakma s/o Satya Kumar Chakma of village Jarulchari under Dighinala upazila and Mrinal Kanti Chakma s/o Chamkhula Chakma of village Shankhola Para under Dighinala upazila were killed in an internal clash relating to distribution of share of illegally collected tolls. In connection to this killing the anti-accord activists filed a false case with Dighinala police station against the following innocent youths-

- 1) Binode Bihari Chakma s/o Ranashova Karbari
- 2) Satya Priya Chakma s/o Jnan Ranjan Chakma
- 3) Kinachan Chakma s/o Janak Chandra Chakma
- 4) Dari Chakma
- 5) Jnana Chakma
- 6) Murati Chakma.

(18) 11 February 1999: Anti-accord elements demanded to hang PCJSS leaders

On 11/2/99 the anti-accord activists held a procession in Khagrachari town and shouted slogan against the PCJSS leaders demanding to hang them (PCJSS leaders).

(19) 11 February 1999: 8 Bengali woodcutters kidnapped by anti-accord elements in Panchari

On 11/2/99 the anti-accord activists namely Budda Muni Chakma, Chandra Jyoti Chakma, Jayanta Bikash Chakma, Ripan Chakma, Rupankar Chakma, Ranakriti Chakma, Mangal Jyoti Chakma, Jalaketu Chakma, Arun Chakma and Riten Chakma kidnapped 8 Bengali woodcutters from Kinaram Karbari Para of Chengi Union under Panchari upazila. They demanded a big amount as ransom. The

armed forces conducted an operation on 13/2/98 and arrested the anti-accord activists including the woodcutters from the jungle of Pujgaong and Kalanal under Panchari with country-made guns. The anti-accord activists were released with the help of the Minister for CHT Affairs Mr. Kalpa Ranjan Chakma on next day.

(20) 12 February 1999: Santu Larma threatened to kill by anti-accord element in Bandarban

On 12/2/99 at a meeting held in Bandarban Sadar, the leader of anti-accord group Mr. Kya Hla Ching Marma threatened to kill PCJSS president Mr. Santu Larma and other leaders of PCJSS.

(21) 14 February 1999: Lynin Bawm tortured by the army in Rowangchari

On 14/2/99 Lynin Bawm, a Christian monk of village Suanalu Para under Rowangchari upazila of Bandarban district was inhumanly beaten up by Major Asaduzaman of Rowangchari army camp. It was Sunday, an holy day for Christian community. Lynin Bawm was asked to make a basket by the army Major while he was going to the Church for prayer. But he (Lynin) refused expressing his incapability of making basket. As a cosequence of his refusal Lynin was severely beaten up and admitted to the Rowangchari hospital.

(22) 14 February 1999: Two PCP members kidnapped by anti-accord elements in Khagrachari

On 14/2/99 the following two PCP members were kidnapped by the anti-accord activists from Munigram area under Khagrachari sadar upazila and they were released after inhuman torture. The victims were;

- 1) Mr. Shyamal Chakma of Rangamati town, Rangamati district
- 2) Mr. Rintu Chakma of Narankhiya, Khagrachari town, Khagrachari district.

(23) 14 February 1999: Four PCP members kidnapped by anti-accord elements in Rangamati

On 14/2/99 the following PCP students were kidnapped by the anti-accord activists from Kutukchari Bazar under Rangamati Sadar upazila in Rangamati district and inhumanly beaten up. The victims were-

- 1) Mr. Kanika Ranjan Chakma of Kutukchari under Rangamati upazila
- 2) Mr. Tridiv Lal Chakma, address- do
- 3) Mr. Kanchan Bihari Chakma, address- do
- 4) Mr. Bijoy Singh Chakma, address- do.

(24) 18 February 1999: Shopkeepers attacked by anti-accord elements in Khagrachari

On 18/2/99 the anti-accord activists made an attack upon shopkeepers of Shivmandir area of Jurmaram under Khagrachari upazila as the shopkeepers protested against illegal toll collection by the anti-accord activists.

(25) 18 February 1999: Communal attack committed by the army in Shiv Mandir

On 18/2/99 a number of Jummas were indiscriminately beaten up and arrested by army personnel at Jurmaram of Bhaibonchara Union under Khagrachari sadar upazila of Khagrachari district while observing their religious festival "Shiva Mela". It happened when a bargaining relating to the auto-rickshaw fares turned to quarrel between the Bengali taxi driver and some Jumma passengers where two vehicles were burnt by some miscreants. Regarding this, the army personnel present there opened gun firing, beaten up the Jummas and arrested 15 with severe injuries. Some of the mass who received severe injuries were admitted to the Khagrachari Sadar Hospital. The held Jummas are listed below:-

- 6) Mr. Mihir Kanti Chakma (30) s/o Hobash Chandra Chakma of Chhotanala, Khagrachari.

(26) 23 February 1999: Four PCP members beat up by anti-accord elements in Panchari

On 23/2/99 the anti-accord activists inhumanly beat up the following PCP members at Pujgang area under Panchari upazila in Khagrachari district. The victims were

(27) 23 February 1999: PCP member kidnapped by anti-accord elements in Khagrachari

On 23/2/99 the anti-accord activists led by Joy Mohan Chakma, Nikalo Chakma and Uttam Kumar Dewan alias Andy kidnapped a PCP member named Jagat Jyoti Chakma from Datkupyra Mohajan Para under Khagrachari upazila. Boikuntha Chakma (60), grandfather of Jogat Jyoti Chakma was also beaten up as he protested against the kidnapping.

(28) 25 February 1999: Two PCP members tortured by anti-accord elements in Mahalchari

On 25/2/99 the following PCP members were kidnapped by the activists of anti-accord group from Karallyachari under Mahalchari upazila and released after inhumanly tortured. The victims were:

March 1999

(29) 16 March 1999: Returnee PCJSS member arrested by the army in Bandarban

On 16 March 1999 the following returnee PCJSS member was held and sent to jail by police without justification. He was falsely alleged to have carried weapon. That day while he was going to Bandarban town from Bali bazar by a jeep all the passengers and their bags were checked by the police personnel of Hafezghona check point where the police found out one pipe gun from a bag kept beside him which infact did not belong to him. Without any justification Labbre Uchai was falsely accused and held. He was released on 13-4-99 on bail and the case is yet to be withdrawn. The victim was:

- 1) Mr. Labbre Uchai s/o Baidya Ram Uchai village under Thanchi upazila of Bandarban district.

(30) 17 March 1999: One Jumma girl tried to entice away by two police personnel in Naniarchar

On 17 March 1999 at midnight 12 O' clock two police personnel named Md. Noman and Md. Masud of Ghilachari police camp of Naniarchar upazila in Rangamati district were nabbed by the villagers of Kukurmara village of the same upazila while trying to entice away one Chakma girl named Sona Bala Chakma from Kukurmara village for sexual harassment.

(31) 19 March 1999: One Jumma beaten by the police for not paying donation for mosque in Rowangchari

On 19/3/99 Mr. Paichibowai Marma (40) was inhumanly beaten up by the IC Md. Raihan of Gharau police outpost under Rowangchari upazila in Bandarban district while he was going to Ruma from Bandarban sadar upazila as he did not able to pay donation for constructing a mosque at Gharau police outpost. Mr. Marma was a poor man.

(32) 21 March 1999: One Jumma beaten brutally by the army in Khagrachari

On 21-3-99 a Jum cultivator (shifting cultivation) named Dhanendra Tripura s/o Falleng Tripura of Barapara village of Baibonchara Union under Khagrachari sadar upazila in Khagrachari district was inhumanly beaten up by army personnel of nearby army camp. That day while returning home from Jum land, he was falsely alleged of burning the Jum land of nearby camp and taken to the camp where 10/12 army personnel led by Nayek Subedar Motaleb had beaten up him severely at the presence of Colonel Mahbub, Zone Commander of Khagrachari army zone.

(33) 27 March 1999: HWF & PCP leaders confined by anti-accord elements in Baghaichari

On 27/3/99 the anti-accord activists in Baghaichari upazila of Rangamati district confined the general secretary of HWF Ms. Nairanjana Chakma and the president of Dighinala upazila branch of PCP Dharmabir Chakma for four hours. They (Mr. Chakma & Ms. Chakma) were there for the purpose of their organizational campaign. Under the tremendous pressure by the local people they (anti-accord group) were compelled to release them.

(34) 27 March 1999: Jumma houses attacked by Awami League cadres in Khagrachari

On 27/3/99 around 9.00 p.m. a grocer shopkeeper was looted by a group of unruly Chakma youths of Juba League, the youth front of ruling Awami League at Khagrachari town. With this regard the Bengalis created communal tension and attack upon the Jumma houses with firearms and sharp metal weapons. In particular, Zahedul Alam, a senior of Awami League and member of Khagrachari Hill District Council shouted loudly to kill the Jummas. The following Jumma houses and valuables were damaged-

- 1) Ms. Shrila Talukdar, Head mistress of Bandarban govt girl high school, Kalyanpur, Khagrachari
- 2) Mr. Tapan Roy, Kalyanpur, Khagrachari

(35) 31 March 1999: Jumma houses attacked by Bengali miscreants in Rangamati town

On 31/3/99 a quarrel took place between one Chakma youth and one Bengali youth at Champaknagar in Rangamati town. Connecting to this, the Bengali made an attack on the Jumma inhabitants of Tribal Adam area of Banarupa in Rangamati town where many Jumma houses were destroyed and some Jummas received injuries.

April 1999

(36) 3 April 1999: Four Chakma youths tortured by Bengali miscreants in Rangamati town

On 3/4/99 regarding launch fare a quarrel took place between four Chakma youths and the launch driver while coming from Barkal to Rangamati Sadar as the Chakma youths were charged excess fare. At the final stage when the launch arrived at Reserved Bazar Ghat of Rangamati, the launch driver started to shouting falsely accusing the Chakma youths of robbing and the Bengali equipped with sticks made attack upon them. Later the Chakma youths were handed over to the police with some Daos fabricating the fact. They were admitted to the Rangamati Sadar Hospital under police custody.

(37) 4 April 1999: Communal attack on Jumma people by the army at Baghaihat

On 4-4-99 the army personnel of Baghaihat army camp led by a captain made a severe attack upon the Jummas came to Baghaihat bazar of Baghaichari upazila under Rangamati district where 51 Jumma people received injuries of which 14 were admitted to the Khagrachari sadar hospital. It was market day. One Chakma girl named Neela Dewan d/o Jnana Ranjan Dewan of village Bhaibonchara of

Baghaihat was objectionably touched her body with evil motive by a Bengali tailor named Nazrul when she went to his tailoring shop for making garments. The quarrel commenced as she raised objection. With a view to reconciling this quarrel while the guardian of the girl with some other Jumma people gathered and started talking to the tailor, 3/4 army personnel arrived there and reviled the Jummas and charged them. At this stage, the army personnel started interrogating the girl and her father away from the tailoring shop and keeping them in separate rooms at a house where the other Jummas raised objection. As retaliation of the raised objection the army aided by other army of the camp attacked them and opened gun firing indiscriminately where 51 got injuries and 5 other were missing. The following Jummas were injured --

(38) 16 April 1999: Chhatra League created communal tension in Rangamati

On 16/4/99 one Bengali activist of BNP was nabbed and tortured by activists of Chhatra League, student wing of Awami League in Rangamati town. In retaliation, the BNP students stabbed one Chakma youth of Chhatra League. And later, this inter-party clash was tried to be turned to communal riot by the Bengalis. The Bengalis equipped with Daos, long sharp knives and sticks tried to commence communal riot. These tense situation had prevailed for a week.

(39) 18 April 1999: PCP member tried to kidnap by anti-accord elements in Khagrachari

On 18/4/99 a group of anti-accord elements led by Bijoy Shankar Chakma s/o Mohendra Chakma and Sama Marma s/o Konjai Marma of Maischari, Khagrachari tried to kidnap a PCP member named Pritibindu Chakma (22) of Nunchari under Khagrachari sadar upazila. It was reported that on 17/4/99 the anti-accord elements surrounded his house and searched for him but he was absent at the time. Next day, while returning home from his uncle's house, was caught by the anti-accord activists. He hardly managed to escape and received injuries in his eye and head.

(40) 19 April 1999: 4 Jumma youths handed over to police by the army and UPDF's members

On 19/4/99 mid-night the army from Karengatali camp under Baghaichari upazila led by captain Shafi in collaboration with anti-accord elements of the UPDF's armed group arrested the following pro-accord youths from Balukhali of Baghaichari upazila in Rangamati district and the victims were handed over to the Baghaichari police station with two pipe guns and one SBBL being falsely accused of keeping it's with them. The following arrested youths were:

(41) 22 April 1999: Public meeting of anti-accord element failed in Khagrachari

On 22/4/99 the PCP members called a meeting at the premises of Khagrachari upazila office protesting against the attack, killing and kidnapping of its members and supporters. On the other hand, the anti-accord activists of Prasit-Sanchoy group with the assistance of local Awami League leaders also called council meeting on the same day at the same place. It was reported by some reliable sources that the anti-accord activists made a blue print to attack on the residence of PCJSS leader and other leaders in name of council meeting. To avoid every possibility of clash between the two rival groups the local administration banned any meeting inside the municipality area. Violating the prohibition the anti-accord activists tried to hold meeting inside Municipality area and were opposed by the police forces. The anti-accord activists, at a stage, started pelting the police with brick-bats and opened gun firing with local made pipe guns, that made the police forces compel to shoot where two anti-accord activists were killed.

(42) 27 April 1999: PCJSS member chopped by anti-accord elements in Panchari

On 27/4/99 one PCJSS member named Dhanyaban Chakma s/o Unachitra Chakma of Napita Para Golak Potimachara under Panchari upazila of Khagrachari district was inhumanly chopped through out his body by some anti-accord activists. The anti-accord elements fled leaving him at the roadside where from the villagers recovered and admitted to the Khagrachari sadar Hospital.

(43) 28 April 1999: Jumma passengers attacked by Bengali settlers in Mahalchari

On 28/4/99 the Bengali settlers of Mahalchari upazila headquarter commenced a communal riot regarding a quarrel between the Jumma passengers and the Bengali boatman. The Bengali settlers made attack upon the Jummas where ten Jummas received severe injuries.

(44) 30 April 1999: Buddhist monk attacked by Bengali settler in Ramgarh

On 30/5/99 a Buddhist monk named Ven. Gnanashree Bhikkhu of Ramgarh Mohamuni Bouddha Bihar in Ramgarh upazila of Khagrachari district was attacked by the Bengali settlers led by Kamal Uddin s/o Chhutu Mian of Daroga Para under Ramgarh upazila in Khagrachari district. The monk received severe injuries in his mouth.

May 1999

(45) 3 May 1999: Two Bengali labourers kidnapped by UPDF in Naniarchar

On 3/5/99, the anti-accord activists kidnapped two Bengali laborers from Jaganatali area under Naniarchar upazila in Rangamati district. The victims were there to dig a pond. The anti-accord activists demanded a big amount of ransom.

(46) 9 May 1999: PCJSS member tried to kidnap by anti-accord elements in Mahalchari

On 9/5/99 some anti-accord activists led by Shaibal Chakma s/o Bira Kishore Chakma of Khullyang Para under Mahalchari upazila tried to kidnap one PCJSS member namely Ziran Talukdar (Happy) s/o Chiranjib Talukdar of Mahajan Para under Khagrachari town from a shop near Mahalchari college.

(47) 12 May 1999: PCJSS member shot dead by anti-accord elements in Guimara

On 12/5/99 one PCJSS member named Kyaja Marma of village Shankhola Para of Guimara area under Matiranga upazila of Khagrachari district was shot dead in an attack committed by the anti-accord activities in Guimara.

(48) 31 May 1999: PCJSS supporter kidnapped by anti-accord elements in Panchari

On 31/5/99 one PCJSS supporter named Kandra Chakma of Kalanal village under Panchari upazila in Khagrachari district was kidnapped from Barakalak area of Logang union under Panchari upazila by a group of anti-accord activists led by Debottam Chakma. He was severely beaten and released at midnight on the same day.

June 1999

(49) 3 June 1999: One returnee Jumma refugee arrested by the police in Khagrachari

On 3/6/99 a returnee Jumma refugee named Mr. Pancha Lal Dewan s/o Jamini Dewan of Bhaibonchara under Khagrachari sadar upazila was arrested by the police personnel of Khagrachari police station. He was falsely accused of stealing. It was learnt that Abdur Rasid, a Bengalee settler of Bhaibonchara bazar illegally occupied the lands of Sindhu Kumar Dewan, brother of Pancha Lal Dewan while they were in refugee camp in India. After returning from India Sindhu Kumar filed a case against Abdur Rasid with Khagrachari Magistrate Court. Meanwhile Abdur Rasid also filed a false case against five Jummas including Sindhu Kumar Dewan and Pancha Lal Dewan in Khagrachari police station falsely accusing of stealing. As a result, the police authority of Khagrachari police station arrested him being biased in favour of Abdur Rasid.

(50) 6 June 1999: Innocent shopkeeper kidnapped by anti-accord elements in Khagrachari

On 6/6/99 the anti-accord activists kidnapped one shopkeeper named Swarga Dhan Chakma s/o Shashinath Chakma of village Munigram from no-6 project area under Khagrachari sadar upazila as he could not able to pay a ransom demanded by them. The police authority was informed but no action has been taken.

(51) 7 June 1999: Communal tension created by Bengali settlers in Dighinala

On 7/6/99 communal tension have been made by the Bengali settlers regarding burying of a settler dead body in Dighinala upazila under Khagrachari district. It was mentionable that the Bengali settlers have made a madrasa and graveyard on the lands of returnee refugees named Tushar Bindu Chakma s/o Punya Kamal Chakma and Bira Kishore Chakma s/o Kripa Sindhu Chakma respectively in Dighinala. After returning from India the said refugees planted banana trees on their lands.

(52) 8 June 1999: PCP member shot dead by anti-accord elements in Mahalchari

On 8/6/99 one PCP student named Utpal Chakma (28) s/o Bira Kishore Chakma was shot dead and another student named Raju Chakma (16) s/o Shanti Kumar Chakma received injuries from an attack by the anti-accord activists in front of the Cinema Hall at Mahalchari bazaar. A case was filed and one anti-accord activist was arrested.

(53) 8 June 1999: One innocent Jumma villager arrested by the police in Khagrachari

On 8/6/99 Mr. Kirit Bhushan Tripura (17) s/o Manju Lakka Tripura of Mahalchari Zero Mile and Mr. Mongchha Tripura (40) s/o Ram Kumar Karbari of Ganja Para under Khagrachari upazila were arrested by the Khagrachari police authority in falsely accusing with looting. It was learnt that district leader of Awami League Mr. Jahedul Alam was looted by the unknown persons at Zero Mile of Khagrachari sadar upazila while he was returning Khagrachari from Dhaka on 19/5/99. But some villagers falsely reported to Mr. Jahedul Alam to get revenge following the village rivalry that Kirit Bhushan Tripura and Mongchha Tripura committed the looting. On the other hand, Manju Lakka Tripura, father of Kirit Bhushan Tripura was arrested on following day by the police in connection with a case GR No.-104/96 that were filed during conflict period while he went to see his son at Khagrachari police station. It is mentionable that all cases including that case which were filed during conflict period were being processed to withdraw according to the CHT Accord.

(54) 10 June 1999: Innocent student kidnapped by anti-accord elements in Khagrachari

On 10/6/99 Arunjoy Dewan (20) s/o Umakanta Dewan of Bhaibonchara Dewan Para under Khagrachari sadar upazila was kidnapped by the anti-accord elements from Shiva Mondir area of Jurmaram under Khagrachari upazila while returning home from Khagrachari Government College. His father Mr. Umakanta Chakma is a PCJSS member and ex-chairman of Bhaibonchara Union Council. He was released after one week with severe injuries.

(55) 14 June 1999: 4 Jumma villagers arrested and tortured by the army in Laxmichari

On 14/7/99 the armed forces from Major Para camp under Laxmichari upazila of Khagrachari district arrested the following youths and handed over to the police after brutally torture. The victims were:

- 1) Mr. Tapas Chakma (35) of village Member Para of Laxmichari upazila
- 2) Mr. Mong She Prue Marma (28) of village Dullyatali under Laxmichari upazila

(56) 14 June 1999: 4 PCP workers arrested and tortured by the police

On 16/7/99 the police authority of Dighinala police station under Khagrachari district arrested the following PCP workers. They were falsely accused in connection with illegal toll collection. They were inhumanly tortured during police custody. The victims were:

August 1999

(57) August 1999: Returnee PCJSS member arrested by the police in Rajasthali

In August 1999 a returnee PCJSS member named Sadhan Tanchangya (Jiten) (23) s/o Bishnu Mohan Tanchangya of village Baga Para under Rajasthali upazila in Rangamati district was arrested by the Rajasthali police authority in connection with false cases and the Upazila Nirbahi Officer (TNO) stopped ration supply for him without having consultation from Accord Implementation Committee.

(58) 20 August 1999: Returnee Jumma refugees evacuated forcibly from transit camp in Dighinala

On 20/08/99 twelve families of returnee refugees residing in the Dighinala Model Primary School transit camp of Dighinala upazila under Khagrachari district have been forcefully evacuated by the police of the Dighinala police station. Twelve including one six-month-old baby were severely injured. Most of the victims are women and children. The incident took place when the police and the VDPs led by the magistrate named Swapan Chandra Pal started beating them (refugees) with gun butts as the refugees refused to leave the school. The returnee refugees were forced to leave without given back their occupied homesteads. The victims were:

(59) 21 August 1999: Communal attack on Jummas committed by the settlers and the army in Dighinala

On 21/08/99 relating to the incident of 20/08/99 two members of DGFI went to the Refugees transit camp to interrogate the refugees where some angry refugees attacked them (DGFI members). Later, this incident was turned into ethnic clash. The Bengali settlers equipped with long sticks and sharp knives and with the assistance of the security forces attacked upon the Jumma people. A BNP leader named Jafar Ahmmmed and a Bengali settler named Kasem led this attack. Two Jummas were arrested and seven Jummas received serious injuries. The arrested were released later. The arrested were:

- 1) Mr. Fatan Tripura (20) s/o Mr. Badin Kumar Tripura of 9 mile (Khagrachari-Dighinala road)
- 2) Mr. Prabhu Ranjan Chakma (22) s/o Mr. Purnendu Chakma of Hachinsonpur, Dighinala upazila.

The injured persons were:

- 1) Mr. Shyamal Chakma (40) s/o Nilamohan Chakma of Betchari, Dighinala
- 2) Mr. Sukhamoy Chakma (30) s/o Kista Lal Chakma of Reservechara, Kobakhali, Dighinala.
- 3) Mr. Ranjit Chakma (25) s/o Ramani Chakma of Gulchari, Dighinala
- 4) Suman Chakma (22) s/o Nlia Kumar Chakma of North Banchara, Dighinala
- 5) Murati Mohan Chakma (26) s/o Noachan Chakma of Gulchari, Dighinala
- 6) Prashanta Chakma (40) s/o Rajani Mohan Chakma of Hajachara, Dighinala
- 7) Nagajya Chakma (35) s/o Singha Chakma of Tarabania, Dighinala.

September 1999

(60) 3 September 1999: PCJSS member kidnapped by UPDF in Manikchari

On 3/9/99 one PCJSS member named Thoi Aung Prue Marma of Barabil Para under Manikchari upazila Khagrachari district was abducted by the anti-accord activists. He was released with severe injuries.

(61) 11 September 1999: Returnee PCJSS member shot dead by anti-accord elements in Khagrachari

On 11/9/99 one PCJSS member named Tridip Chakma alias Arjin (32) s/o Dayaram Chakma of Jurmaram under Khagrachari sadar upazila was killed by a gun attack committed by the anti-accord activists led by Debadanta Tripura.

(62) 24 September 1999: Communal tension created by Bengali settlers in Panchari

On 24/09/99 there was tense situation in Panchari upazila of Khagrachari district relating to the killing of one Bengali businessman by some unidentified miscreants. The police recovered the dead body of Sujat Ali from the jungle near Logang bazaar under Panchari upazila in Khagrachari on 24/09/99. The Bengali settlers of Panchari and Logang brought out demonstration and attempted to attack on the Jumma. The Jummas were compelled to boycott the bazaar.

October 1999

(63) 7 October 1999: PCJSS supporter kidnapped by anti-elements in Laxmichari

On 7/10/99 one supporter of PCJSS named Tuthya Chakma of village Banyachara under Laxmichari upazila in Khagrachari district was kidnapped by the anti-accord activists. He is supposed to have been killed.

(64) 16 October 1999: Massive communal attack made by the army and Bengali settlers in Babuchara

On 16/10/99 the army and the Bengali settlers made a severe attack on the Jumma at Babuchara Bazaar of Dighinala upazila in Khagrachari Hill District. Three Jumma were killed and more than hundred received serious injuries. It happened when one army personnel touched the breast of one Jumma girl named Ms. Mitti Chakma (16) d/o Nilajoy Chakma of village Baghaichari in Dighinala. When Mitti Chakma shouted catching the hand of the Habildar named Jahir then the he (Habildar) pushed her where she felt on the ground. Then some Jumma came to rescue her. The Habildar caught one Jumma and started beating with the help of his colleague named constable Alam. Then all the Jummas of the Bazaar gathered and started beating the two-army personnel. Later, the army from the nearby camps and Bengali of the bazaar jointly started beating the jummas indiscriminately and ransacked the shops of the jummas. Later some children and women were brought to the nearby army camp where they (Jumma) were severely beaten by gun butts and sticks. Two Jumma youth were confined to the camp that were released later with serious injuries and admitted to hospital. Meanwhile, a group of army led by Major Kalam, with the help of Bengali settlers went to a village where they ransacked the Jumma's houses and beat indiscriminately. Another group of army and settlers led by one Major attacked the Karbari Tila village where many houses and one Buddhist temple were destroyed and two monks were seriously beaten.

According to the government sources, 4 persons including 3 Jummas and Bengali were killed and 140 including 8 Bengalis and 3 Buddhist Monks were injured. The injured 3 Buddhist Monks were-

- 1) Ven. Rakshit Bikkhu, Head Monk of the Benuban Boudha Bihar
- 2) Ven. Bipani Bikkhu, Assistant Head Monk of the Benuban Bouddha Bihar
- 3) Ven. Uttamalankar Bikkhu, Head Monk of Katarungchara Bouddha Bihar.

The injured persons have been got admission to the following hospital/medical centres-

- 3) Mr. Sukamal Chakma (35) s/o Toinya Chakma of village Madyam Baghaichari under Dighinala upazila

Despite this one Bengali named Yusuf Ali (40) was dead in Chittagong Medical College Hospital in this incident.

(65) October 1999: PCJSS supporter attacked by anti-accord elements in Laxmichari

In October 1999 one PCJSS supporter named Maya Bhushan Chakma s/o Purna Kumar Chakma of Chalyatali Para under Laxmichari upazila in Khagrachari district was attacked thrice by the armed anti-accord activists.

November 1999

(66) 16 November 1999: PCP leader killed by anti-accord elements in Khagrachari

On 16/11/99 in a gun attack, one Pahari Chatra Parisad (PCP) leader named Mr. Suniti Bikash Chakma was killed and Mr. Bodhisatta Chakma, a returnee member of PCJSS received serious bullet injuries. A gang of anti-accord (Prasit-Sanchoy) group committed it. This killing took place at Christian Para village of Itchari mouza under Khagrachari upazila in Khagrachari district on their way to Khagrachari town. The armed gang opened fire from the nearby jungle.

(67) 16 November 1999: Returnee PCJSS member killed by anti-accord elements in Panchari

On 16/11/99 one PCJSS member named Mr. Arun Shanti Chakma (28) was killed by a group of anti-accord elements (Prasit-Sanchoy group) led by Debattam Chakma at his resident at village Barapera of Panchari upazila in Khagrachari district. On that day at 8 PM local time the group equipped with arms surrounded his house and took him away where he was killed by gun shooting.

(68) 18 November 1999: PCP member abducted by anti-accord elements in Rangamati

On 18/11/99 one PCP leader named Mohatma Dewan (30) was abducted from a bus by a group of anti-accord activists (Prasit-Sanchoy) from Kotukchari area of Rangamati district. He was on his way to Rangamati from Khagrachari. He was rescued after three days. He was beaten inhumanly.

(69) 25 November 1999: Two Jumma woodcutters kidnapped by anti-accord elements in Laxmichari

On 25/11/99 Anti-peace accord group (Prasit-Sanchoy) abducted two woodcutters, who are supporters of PCJSS, namely Momong Marma (28) and Rame Aung Marma (25) from the deep Forrest of Banarkata area of Laxmichari upazila in Khagrachari district. The victims were taken blindfolded to the jungle where they were inhumanly beaten and released with the help of local people.

(70) 27 November 1999: Returnee PCJSS member kidnapped by anti-accord elements in Bankdukhangha

On 27/11/99 a member of PCJSS named Bishantar Chakma (48) s/o Suresh Chandra Chakma of village Laikhyongchara of Bandukbhanga union under Rangamati sadar upazila in Rangamati district was kidnapped by a group of anti-accord activist (Prasit-Sanchoy group) led by Sachib Chakma. About 16 activists surrounded the house of Bishantar Chakma and took him blind-folded to the deep forest at gunpoint early in the morning. They (anti-accord activists) demanded a ransom of Taka 500,000/= for his release. He was released on 6/12/99.

(71) 28 November 1999: Jumma girl abducted by Bengali miscreants in Manikchari

On 28/11/1999 Miss Junima Marma (14) (SSC candidate) d/o Kyaja Marma of village Kalapani under Manikchari upazila in Khagrachari district was kidnapped by a group of 15/20 Bengali youths led by Mr. Habib (26) s/o Abdul of village Pilkhana of Dandmara union under Fatikchari upazila in Chittagong district. This day at 12.00 noon the abductors with firearms rounded up Junima's house and then beat Junima Marma's parent. Habib was a member of Bangladesh Chhatra League cadre.

(72) 29 November 1999: PCP member kidnapped by anti-accord elements in Bhandukbhanga

On 29/11/99 Pratibha Chakma, a member of PCP of village Debachara of Bandukbhanga mouza under Rangamati sadar upazila of Rangamati district was abducted by the activist of anti-peace accord elements led by Prasit-Sanchoy group. He was rescued after one day with critical injuries.

December 1999

(73) 5 December 1999: PCJSS local leader kidnapped by anti-accord elements in Laxmichari

On 5/12/99 two persons including one PCJSS leader has been abducted by a group of 30/40 anti-accord activist (Prasit-Sanchoy) from his residence of the village Hatichara under Laxmichai upazila in Khagrachari district. The name of PCJSS leader is U Sha Thoi Marma (32). He and his guest were taken to the jungle at gunpoint. The abductors assaulted the wife and children of Mr. Marma. They (Abductors) also threatened them to death if inform the police.

(74) 9 December 1999: PCJSS member shot by anti-accord elements in Kutukchari

On 9/12/99 one PCJSS member named Sadhan Kumar Chakma (24) s/o Natun Joy Chakma of village Kabukchara of Ghilachari Union under Naniarchar uoazila in Rangamati district was shot by a group of 15/16 anti-accord activists led by Abhilash Chakma and Priti Kumar Chakma. He, along with some of his friends, was on the way to Ghilachari bazaar from his village Kabukchara. He received bullet injuries at his leg and abdomen. The victim was sent to Chittagong Medical College Hospital.

(75) 12-13 December 1999: Returnee PCJSS member shot dead by Baghaichari

Midnight between 12-13/12/99 a returnee PCJSS member named Mr. Manin Chakma (Tarjen) s/o Laxmi Chandra Chakma of village Bangaltali under Baghaichari upazila in Rangamati district was shot dead at his house by the anti-accord group.

(76) 17 December 1999: False case filed against PCJSS member in Manikchari

On 17/12/1999 Mr. Kangjari Marma, leader of the then rulling Awami League of Manikchari upazila in collaboration with Manikichari police authority filed a false case (No. GR-6 date 17/12/99) against the following PCJSS members in connection with kidnapping of one anti-accord member Mongshe Marma. However, Mongsajai Marma was absence in Manikchari at that time. He was in Khagrachari town.

- 1) Mr. Mongsajai Marma alias Japan (41) s/o Ra Aung Marma of village Tintahari of Manikchari upazila;
- 2) Mr. Mongpu Marma (28) s/o Ninghla Aung Marma of village Manikchari sadar;
- 3) Mr. Kyaja Marma (42) of village Batnatali of Manikchari upazila.

(77) 29 December 1999: Valuables of villagers destroyed by anti-accord elements in Dighinala

On 29/12/99 a group of anti-accord elements equipped with arms rounded up Noapara village of Babuchara under Dighinala upazila and searched houses of Purna Kumar Chakma (46) (Assistant

Teacher of Babuchara Primary School) s/o Uda Chakma, Kalendra Lal Chakma (50), Ex-member of Babuchara Union Council and Jnana Priya Chakma (30) s/o Dharendra Lal Chakma. They were absent at that time but valuables of the houses were destroyed by the anti-accord miscreants of Prasiy-Sanchay group.

(78) December 1999: False case filed against PCJSS member in Laxmichari

End of the year of 1999 the Sub-Inspector of Laxmichari police station Md. Mohsin Ali filed a case [No. GR-202/99 section 19(ka)cha] against the following PCJSS members and supporters in connection with keeping arms. It was learnt that a country-made gun was recovered from a bus by the army and the following persons were falsely accused with this incident in order to harass the members of the PCJSS and PCP. The victims were:

- 1) Mr. Sathowai Aung Marma (28) s/o Paiyo Marma of village West Chilyatali of Dulyatali UP under Laxmichari upazila, PCPCPCJSS Convenor of Laxmichari branch;
- 2) Mr. Kanak Chakma (27) of village South Shuknachari of Brahmachari UP, PCPCPCJSS Joint Convenor of Laxmichari branch;
- 3) Mr. Uchakhoi Marma (33) s/o late Hlathowai Aung Marma of village Hatimara of Laxmichari UP, PCPCPCJSS member;
- 4) Mr. Bishnu Dev Chakma (26) s/o Roy Ranjan Chakma of village Dewan Para of Dulyatali UP, PCP member;
- 5) Mr. Pai Chau Marma (24) s/o Mongsa Thowai Marma of village Hazachari Master Para of Dulyatali UP, General Secretary of PCP of Laxmichari branch;
- 6) Mr. Mong Chaigya Marma (25) s/o Aungsu Prue Marma of village Dulyatali of Dulyatali UP;
- 7) Mr. Satya Marma (27) s/o Merela Marma of village Dulyatali.
